Use this informational sheet to help ask important questions prior to
enrolling in a clinical trial for Krabbe disease.

QUESTIONS FOR THE PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR:

- 1. How many participants have enrolled in this clinical trial thus far?
- 2. What is the total time commitment to participate in the clinical trial from start to end?
- 3. What's the mean age of the participants enrolled in this clinical trial?
- 4. What other treatments are utilized for Krabbe disease?
- 5. What types of long-term benefits are expected for participants?
- 6. Does participation in this trial disqualify participants from other clinical trials and/or treatments?
- 7. What expenses will or will not be covered for participants in this clinical trial?
- 8. Will we need to relocate and if yes, are those costs covered?
- 9. What follow-up visits and tests will be required for participates in this clinical trial?
- 10. Will we receive a stipend for our participation in this clinical trial to help offset out-of-pocket costs?
- 11. What are the risks and side effects of the treatment. How many participants experience the side effects?
- 12. Who will have access to participant information due to our enrollment in this clinical trial?
- 13. Will we receive copies of information collected in this clinical trial? For example, results from genetic testing, copies of MRI's, developmental testing, clinical trial outcomes, and more.
- 14. How do you partner with local doctor/s to ensure participants receive necessary support upon return of home?
- 15. Are participants allowed to be removed from the clinical trial at any point in time?
