Fund vs. Foundation Comparison

Category	Family Advised Fund	Foundation
Start-up Time	Immediate ability to fund projects upon availability of funds	Can take several weeks or months to begin funding projects because all legal and administrative documents need to be filed/IRS approved
Start-Up Costs	None	Legal and other startup fees are typically substantial and can cost thousands of dollars to create a foundation.
Ongoing Admin, Legal, and Accounting Fees	Average is 5%-10%, KrabbeConnect currently administers a nominal fee.	\$3,000-\$5,000/year or more
Privacy	Names of individual donors can be kept confidential if desired, and grants can be made anonymously	Must file detailed and public tax returns on grants, investment fees, staff salaries, and more
Reporting	None	Required annual state and federal tax returns-time consuming and requires an expert accountant in the non-profit space
Governance	None	For incorporation purposes, must develop by-laws and board documents, overseen by a formal board



The Steps:

- Reach out to KrabbeConnect at info@krabbeconnect.org
- 2. Stacy and/or Anne set up a meeting to review the program with the family.
- 3. Family decides to move forward.
- 4. Family petitions to board of director a name for their fund.
- 5. KrabbeConnect and family complete contractual agreement.
- 6. The family acts as advisors and successors to the fund in perpetuity.
